Volunteers were asked to sign in and provide the name of a cancer survivor to whom they dedicated their efforts. Each volunteer was assigned to one of five stations: ironing, pinning, sewing, etc.

We had hoped to complete at least 100 pouches in the time allotted and were thrilled to assemble 257 pouches! The bags were taken to the Coliseum Hospital in Macon for distribution.
